



Harp Workshop Day

with Sarah Ridy

- WHO** NEEMF (North East Early Music Forum) and The Clarsach Society Transpennine Branch invite players of harps (non pedal but of any size) and other plucked and bowed continuo instruments to a day exploring and demonstrating improvisations and diminutions over a ground bass using well known 16th and 17th century material, including Farinell's ground and the ciaccona bass line. Depending on numbers the format can be flexible so bring a favourite tune to work on if you wish. Pitch will be A=440 Hz . Sarah graduated from RNCM with a degree in pedal harp performance before specializing on the Baroque triple harp in The Hague with Christina Pluhar. Now based in Brussels she performs in solo concerts and with many groups including l'Arpeggiata, Scherzi Musicali, Ensemble Elyma, Ricercar Consort, Me La Amargates Tú and Zefiro Torna.

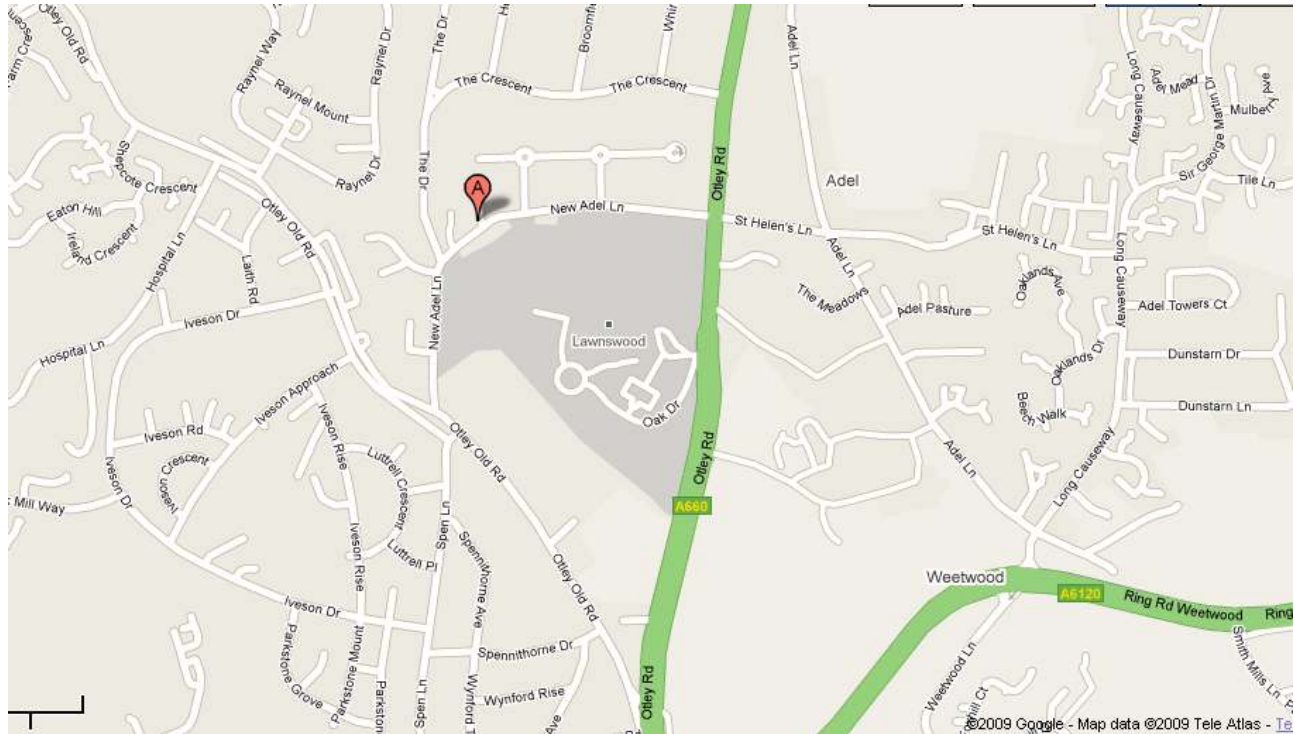

Map and Directions:



Approaching from the South, East or West take the Leeds Ring Road (A6120) until you reach the Lawnswood roundabout for the A660, signposted North for Otley/Skipton . Turn left into New Adel Lane shortly after the Esso station (on the right). **The Meeting House is on a bend on the right side of the road – turn into the lane leading to the car park.**

From the North, take the A660 towards Leeds through Bramhope, passing Golden Acre Park and the Parkway Hotel (now called Ramada Jarvis). After the 40 mph sign there is a set of traffic lights – take the second turning right after these into New Adel Lane then follow the directions in bold above.
