

Venue:

Durham City Methodist Church, North Road, Durham, DH1 4SG. Entrance via the side door, not the main door up the steps. There is a lift.

Transport:

The church is easily accessible via bus or rail. PLEASE USE PUBLIC TRANSPORT IF YOU CAN.

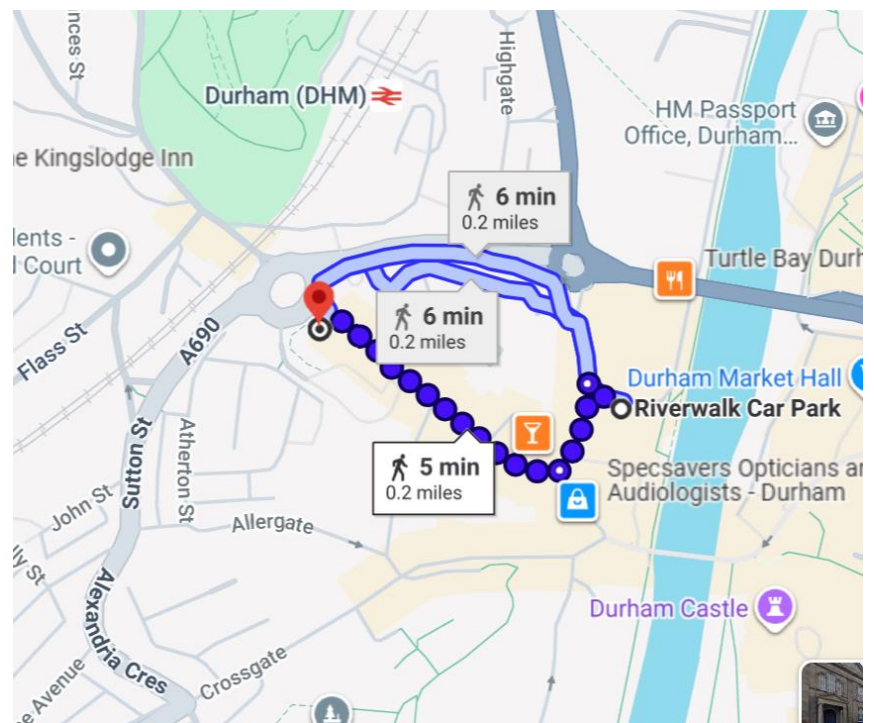
BY TRAIN - 5 minutes walk

BY BUS The bus station is a 1 minute walk.

BY CAR If you are bringing heavy boxes or a large/heavy instrument or cannot walk any distance, please let me know as there are a very few spaces at the church. If you cannot get into the church car park, the closest car park is Riverwalk Car Park 3 Millburngate, Durham DH1 4SL. This is 5 minutes walk from the church, but does cost £10 to park for the day. A slightly cheaper car park at £8 per day is the LNER long stay car park off Framwellgate Peth, but this is a 13 minutes walk up a steep hill and I cannot find a postcode for this car park. Free parking is possible at the Durham Park & Ride car parks. A day pass costs £2.20 per person (free after 9.30am with bus pass). Buses run from the Park & Ride car parks every 15 minutes. PR1 (Belmont to Snipperley) and PR2 (Howlands Farm) both go to Leazes Road, Millburngate Bridge (westbound) or Leazes Road Underpass Stand A (eastbound) which is a 7 minute (east) or 10 minutes (west) walk from the North Road Methodist church. Temperature:
